



NRS Petro Release Update 2.1 - June 2022

Cash Returned

Cash customers can now receive their change up front prior to fueling. Click the “Give Change Now” button on the pump panel to capture the fact that the change was given. This is available for stand alone fuel and mixed merchandise with fuel transactions.

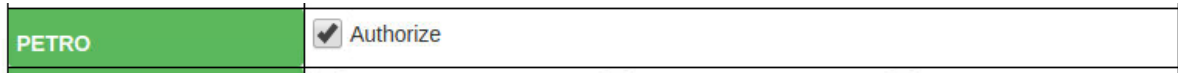

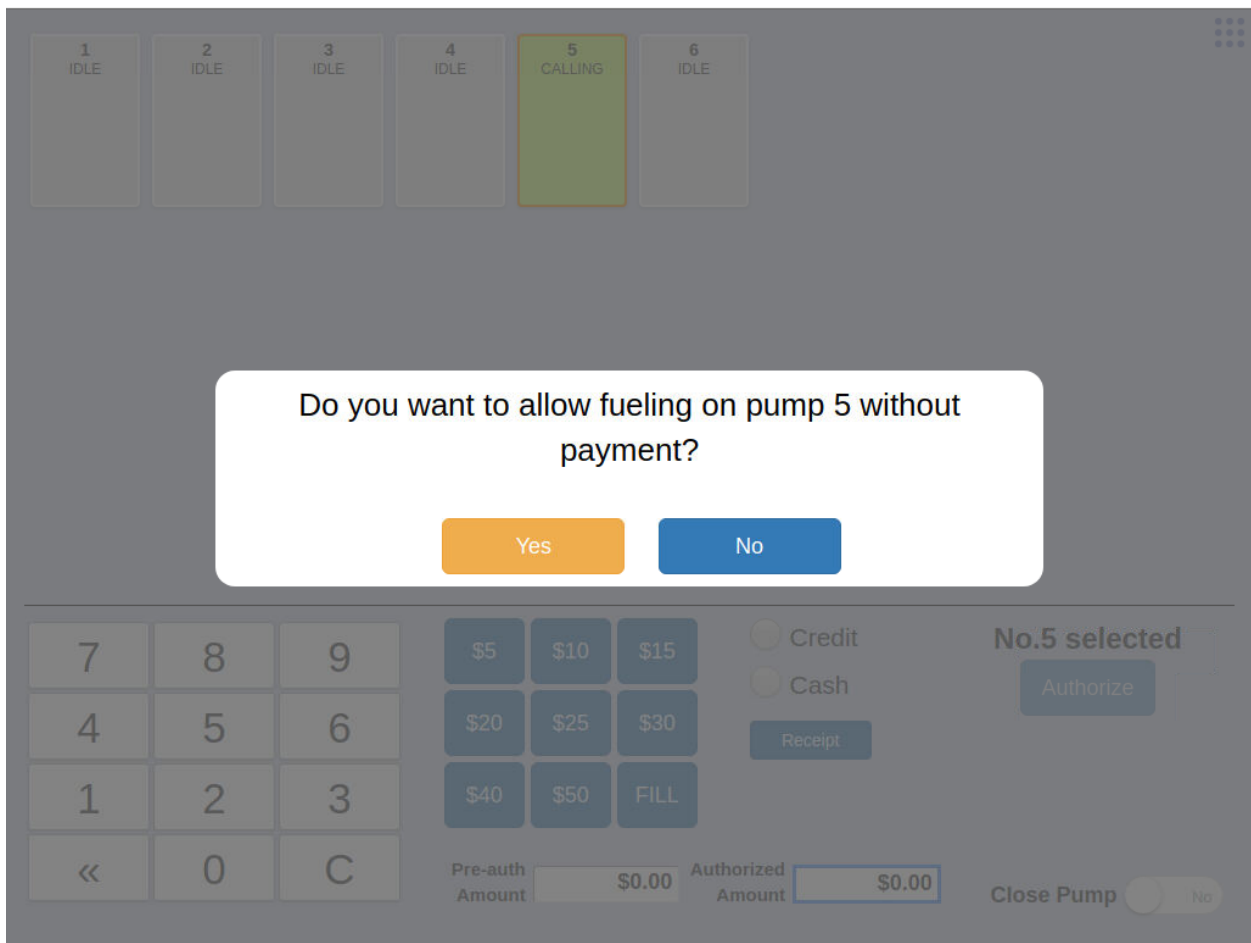
Even in cases where the full authorized amount was not dispensed, the register will provide the details of the cash tendered, cash returned and correct amount of change due.

Post Pay

Small town stations can now offer their regular customers the option to pump prior to payment. The customer can lift the nozzle, select a grade and signal the POS for authorization. With the Petro > Authorize permission,



the cashier can authorize the fueling prior to payment.



For stations with different pricing for cash and credit, the fuel will be priced based on the payment type selected at the conclusion of the sale. Merchandise can be added to the basket prior to closing out the sale.
