Free upgrade to Advanced Plan for all Panther users signed up before April 1, 2025

All existing Panther users will be upgraded to the Advanced plan free for one year.

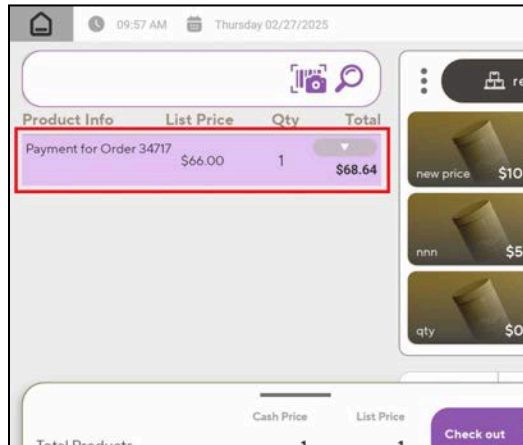
This promotion will give merchants a smooth transition period to experience premium features before regular billing resumes.

You will receive an email explaining the promo details and reminders as the free period nears its end. At the conclusion of the free year, Advanced plan billing will resume unless you opt to downgrade.

Online Pay-in-Store Orders

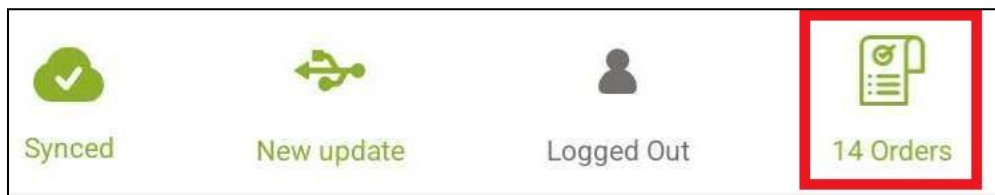
Merchants will now be able to automatically send online orders into Panther POS from the Order Management System and process the payments for these orders in store.

The cashier can choose to load the online order into the register from the Order Management System. When they do this, the online order is loaded into the register as a non-editable basket with a single line item.



OM Status Tray Icon

A new status tray icon at the top of the screen shows real-time online order updates: a green icon when new orders exist, gray if none, and the number of orders that are available.

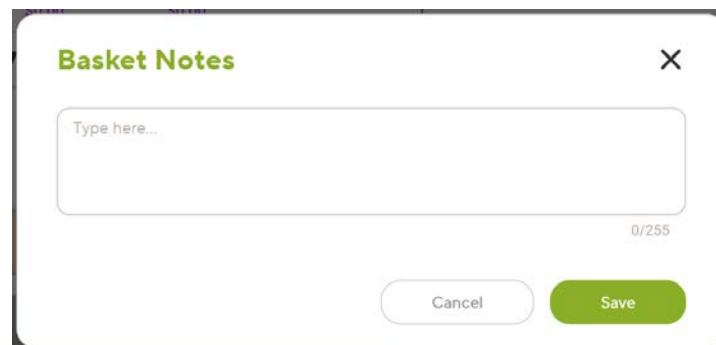
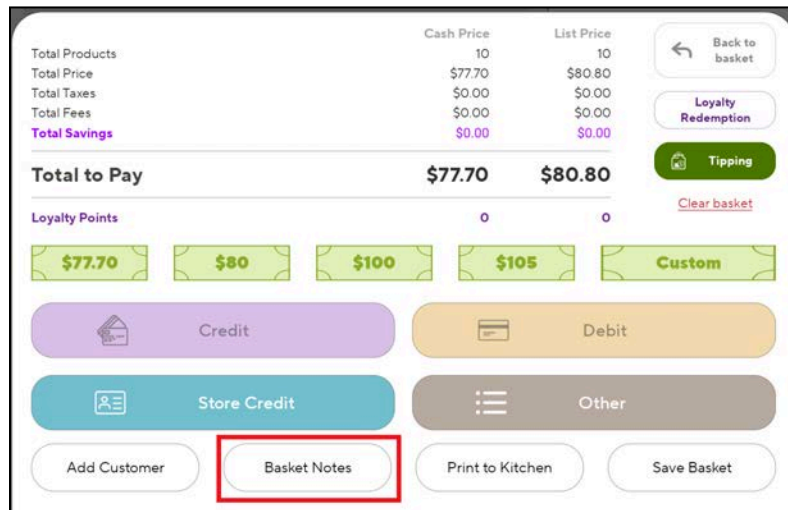


When Order Management opens you will see the cards for each order. When you select an order to pick, the order locks so no one else can edit or cancel the order.

Basket Notes

The Basket Notes feature lets you add text notes to an order, capturing additional details or special instructions as part of the basket check out process.

You can add/edit notes from the expanded payment screen.



Editing notes is only allowed before payment is finalized. After the sale is completed, notes cannot be edited.


Notes are viewable in the receipt and in the transaction view. They are also included in the printout sent to the kitchen.

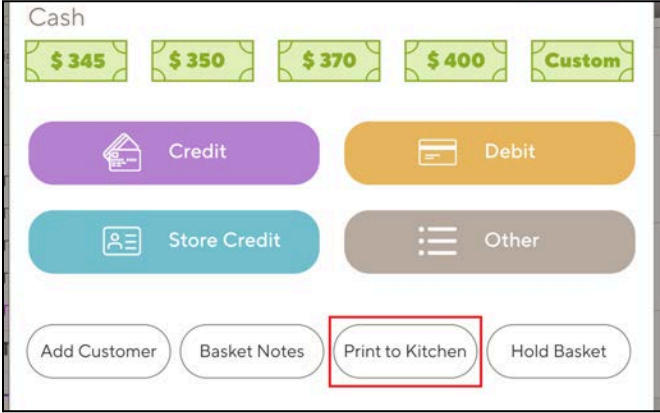

Print to Kitchen

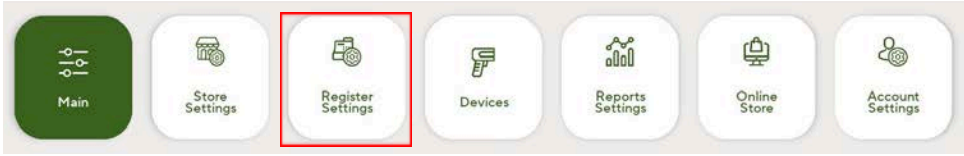
Panther POS now supports advanced printing options that let you tailor how kitchen orders are handled, saved, and reprinted.



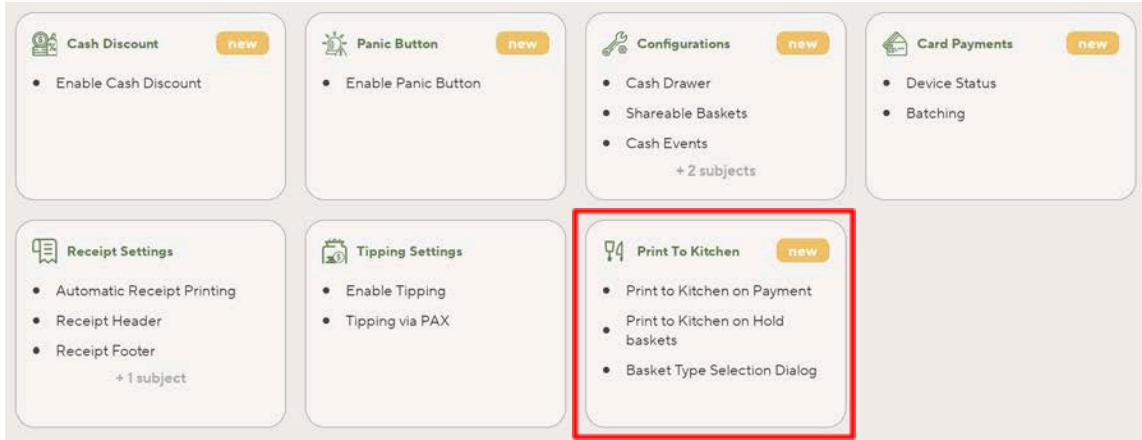
Start configuring Print to Kitchen by tapping on Settings from the Home Menu.



Then select Register Settings



At the next screen select the new Print to Kitchen button.



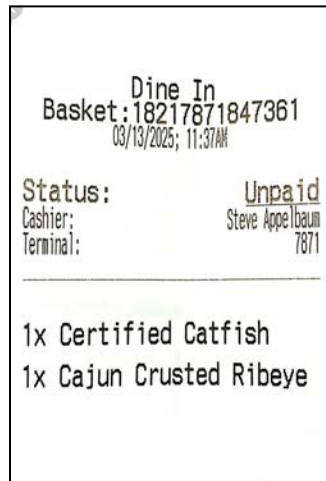
The following menu opens up.



Automatically Print to Kitchen on Payment: The basket is printed to the kitchen when paid.



Automatically Print to Kitchen on Hold Basket: The basket is printed to the kitchen when it is put on **hold**.



Warn on Duplicate Kitchen Printing: Warn if the same basket is printed twice to the kitchen (which may lead to the kitchen preparing the same order twice).

Reduce Quantity of an Item

The updated slip specifies the item that was updated, and shows the new quantity or other changes.

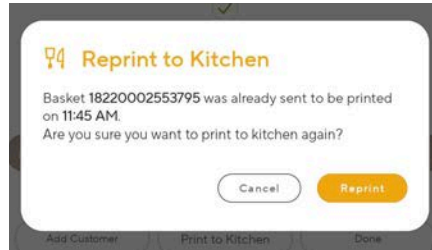
Additional details (e.g., modifiers, updated comments) are included under the same “Update” label if needed.

Remove/Add Modifiers

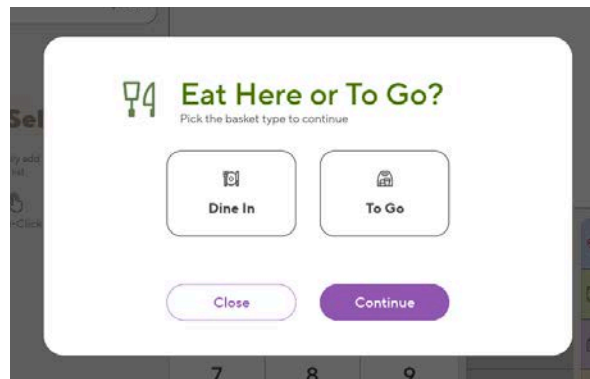
If a modifier is removed, then **the old combination of product + modifier** is shown as **voided**, and the **new combination of product + modifier** is shown as **new**.

Add, Remove, or Change Multiple Items

Multiple operations (add/remove/change) may happen at once.



Display Basket Type Selection Dialog: When the first item is added to a new basket, a dialog box will appear with the options of “To Go” and “Dine In”.



When a basket is saved or put on hold, the system sends a printout to confirm the order state at that time.

If a basket changes (items added, modified, or removed), subsequent printouts reflect the updates.

Merchants can enable printing for selected departments, ensuring only products from those departments print to the kitchen

Adjusting the Business Day Time

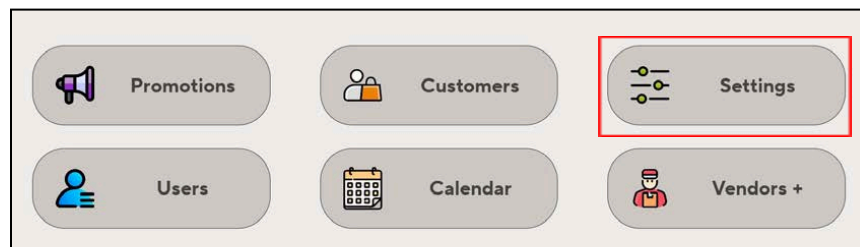
By default, Panther POS treats each calendar day (midnight to midnight) as the “business day.” However, many stores operate beyond midnight, causing Panther POS to include portions of yesterday’s sales in “today’s” report (or vice versa).

For example, if your store closes at 2:00 AM but keeps the default (midnight) as its business day start, any sales made between midnight and 2:00 AM are included in the next day’s data.

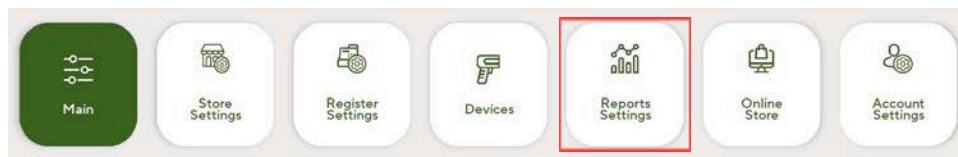
It is now possible for you to adjust the start of the business day working hours, which corrects this late-night overlap issue.

By selecting a start time that aligns with your store’s closing or opening hours you ensure that “today’s” report accurately reflects a full 24-hour operational window. For example, setting your start time to 2:00 AM ensures that a “today” report only captures the period starting from 2:00 AM to 2:00 AM the following day, which matches the operational hours.

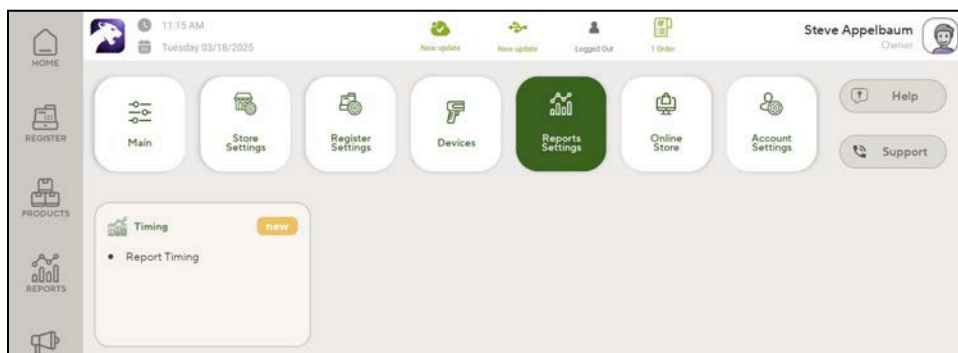
In Panther POS from the Home screen navigate to **Settings**



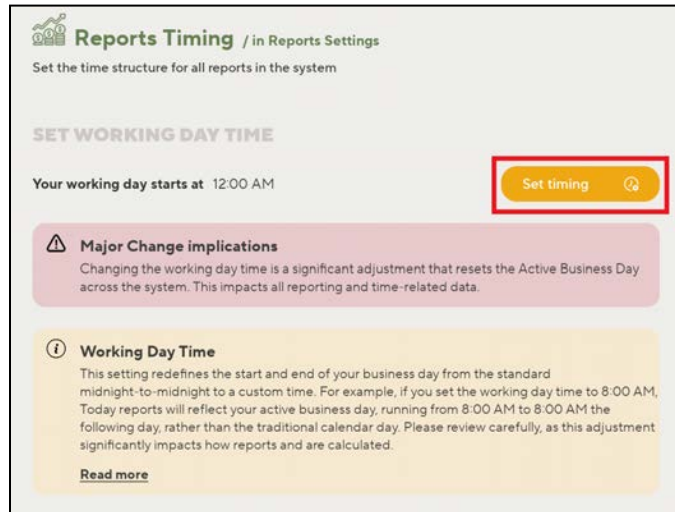
Tap **Reports Settings**



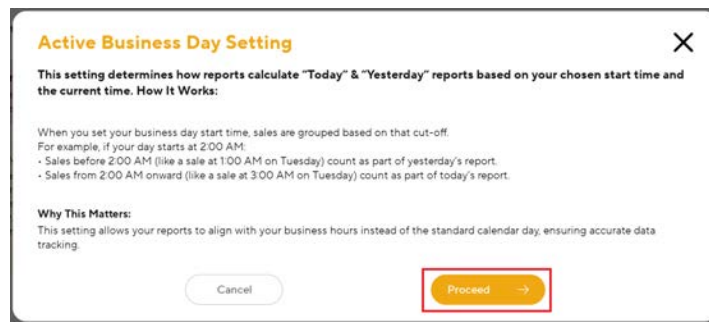
Tap **Report Timings** to view the current start time of your working day



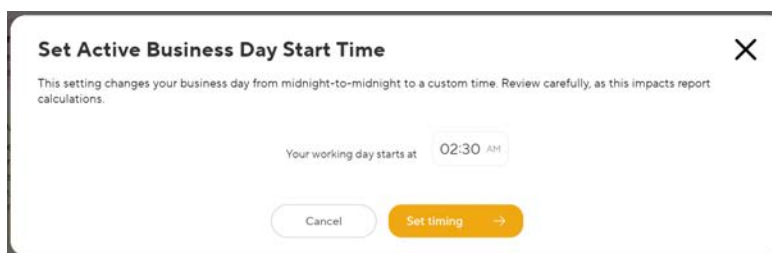
To change this setting, press the **Set Timing** button.



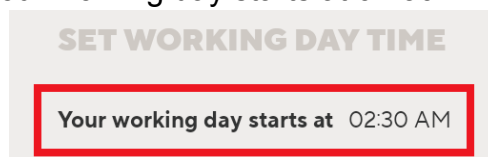
A popup will appear warning you about the implications of modifying your working day's start time. If you wish to continue, tap **Proceed**.



In the next popup screen, select the current start time to choose a new hour and minute.



Finally, tap **Set Timing** to confirm your selection. The new start time will then be displayed (for example, "Your working day starts at 02:30 AM").



Pay in Store Orders Report

A new **Pay In Store Orders** section in the **End of Day report** differentiates online orders paid in store from other transactions.

Enhancements

Price-Embedded UPC

This feature enables Panther POS to recognize and process UPCs that include embedded pricing information. When a UPC is scanned that follows the “price embedded UPC” format, the system extracts both the product’s PLU and the embedded price—overriding the default product price—to ensure the correct price is applied during checkout.

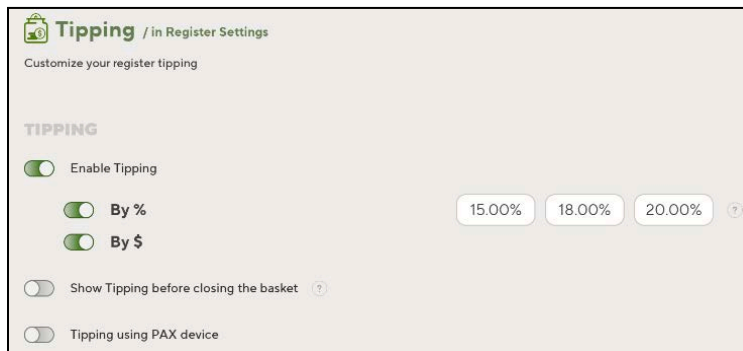
The system reads the embedded price from the UPC code and uses it instead of the regular price stored in the price book for that product.

New Tipping Settings

Tipping settings have been moved from a general configuration section into their own dedicated category under “Register Settings.”

Additionally, the tipping flow has been made more intuitive for staff and customers through removing or reorganizing buttons and labels.
