Auto Create PLU on Product Creation

Added a new button to auto generate new plu based on existing ones in a numeric incremental number.

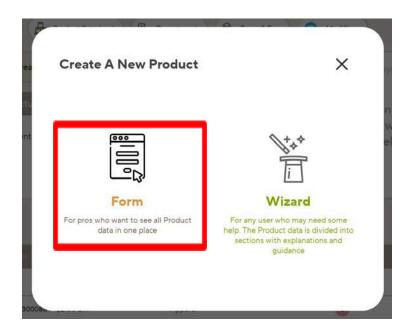
Starting from the **Home** screen, select **Products**



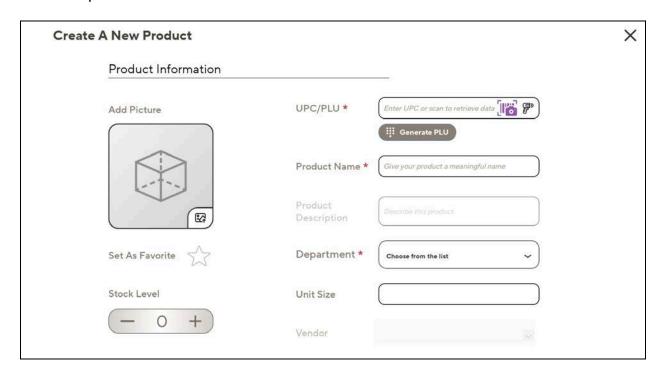
Then tap the **Create A New Product** button.



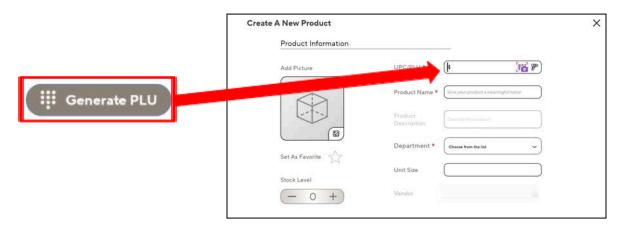
In the pop up window select Form



This will open the Create A New Product screen.

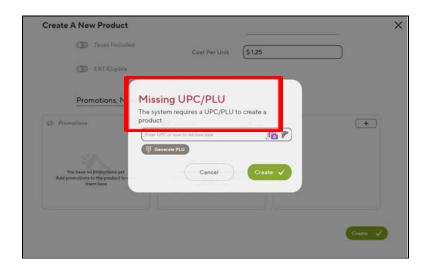


Tapping on the **Generate PLU** button will auto populate the **UPC/PLU** field with a valid PLU for your store.



If the user tries to save a product without entering a UPC/PLU, a message box pops up:

Missing UPC/PLU – The system requires a UPC/PLU to create a product



The message-box contains a UPC/PLU input field (editable) for you to scan/enter a UPC and a **Generate PLU** button.

Tapping the green **Create** button validates the generated/entered PLU and creates the product. The **Cancel** button cancels the entry and returns to the previous screen.

Entering the UPC or PLU by scan or auto entry eliminates manual typing errors and makes pricebook maintenance easier by guaranteeing each PLU is store-unique.

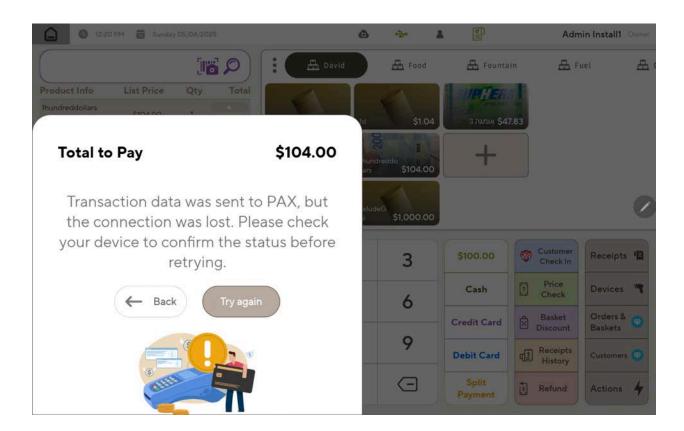
Managing Disconnections During a Transaction

A new payment workflow has eliminated two common payment issues:

- A sale that finishes on the PAX terminal but never reaches Panther.
- Accidental double-billing after a connection dropout.

Panther now logs or voids a sale **only after** the PAX terminal returns a definitive status.

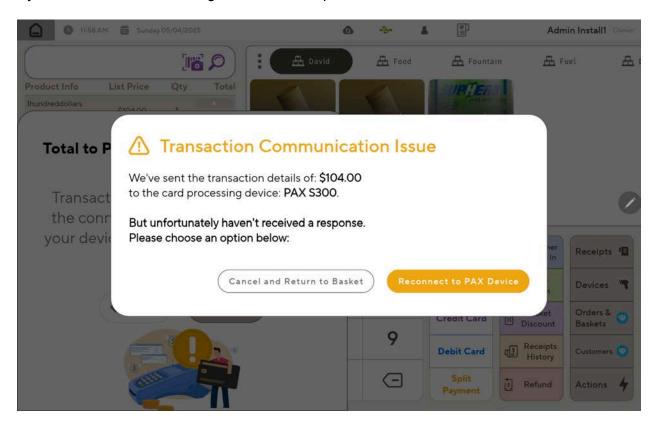
If Wi-Fi drops mid-authorization, Panther makes background reconnection attempts (30 seconds on the PAX-side, 60 seconds on POSLink). If the link is re-established, the Pax pulls the transaction from the terminal and completes the sale, without any cashier action needed.



When pressing Try Again - First. Panther will scan the network to reconnect to the Pax unit. If it auto-connects - Panther will Query the pax unit to see if it is already charged for this transaction (it will not actually send a new transaction). If it does not find the transaction, it will automatically attempt to process the transaction again.

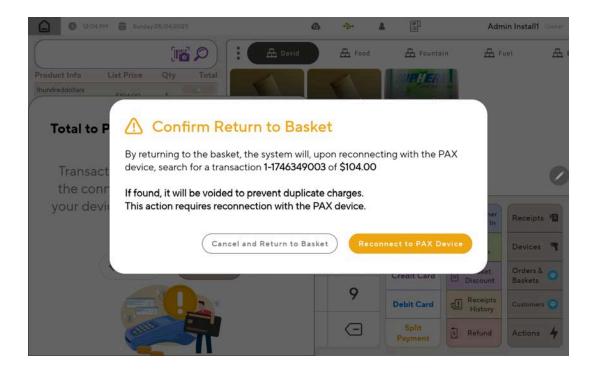
If you press Back, then a new pop up displays (next picture).. See below.

If you select Back the following screen comes up.



If you select **Cancel and Return to Basket** a popup window will open explaining that the system will void the transaction (as an orphan - uncompleted transaction) when it does reconnect. You must then tap the **Cancel and Return to Basket** button again to initiate this process. You will be returned to the checkout for you to try the transaction again.

This window - the confirm and return to basket only comes up if the transaction did not complete and the customer wants to use another method of payment.

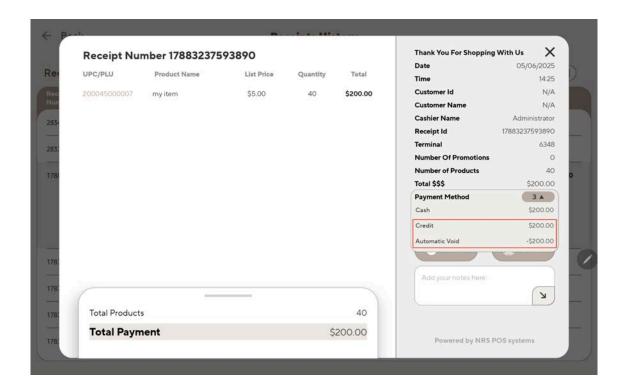


After Wi-Fi is back, Panther checks the terminal for orphaned authorizations that match any ghost baskets and voids them automatically, logging these as **Automatic Void** on receipts and in reports.

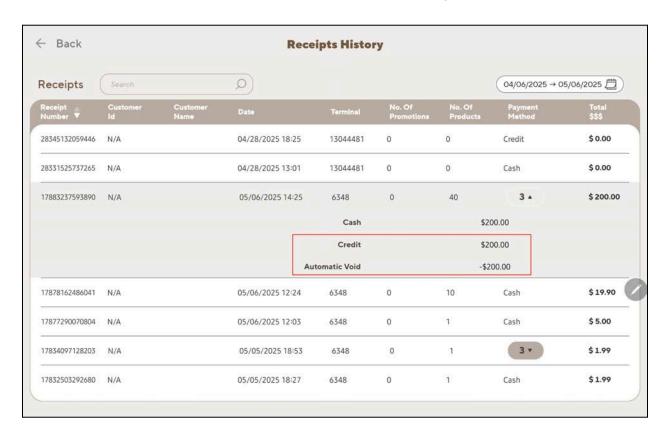
This only shows when you press Back or Cancel and Return to Basket. This is to absolutely confirm that they intend to go back to the basket to pay a different way (since pax devices are not connected). Once confirmed to go back to the basket, it will show the basket as it was before the attempted CC transaction. In the background, the transaction record is still a "Ghost Record".

Once the pax unit reconnects, Panther will query to see if that transaction did go through. If it did, it will be voided and the CC transaction record will also be voided. It will only be voided if (and only if) we reconnect to the same device and the transaction actually went through. The reason it will be voided is because it would have been paid a different way.

The following picture from the receipts indicates that the transaction did go thru but it was automatically voided because it was paid in a different tender.

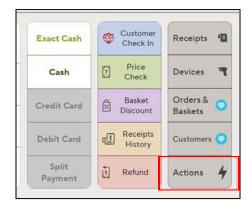


This window shows the above transaction from the receipts history view.



Improved End of Day Reporting

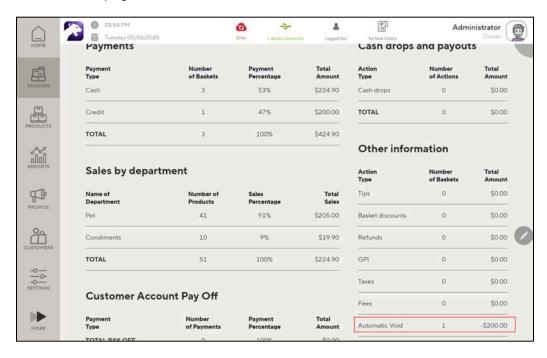
From the register screen, Tap the **Actions** button and select the **End of Day Reports**.





The End of Day report opens showing a detailed view of all sales from your Panther POS.

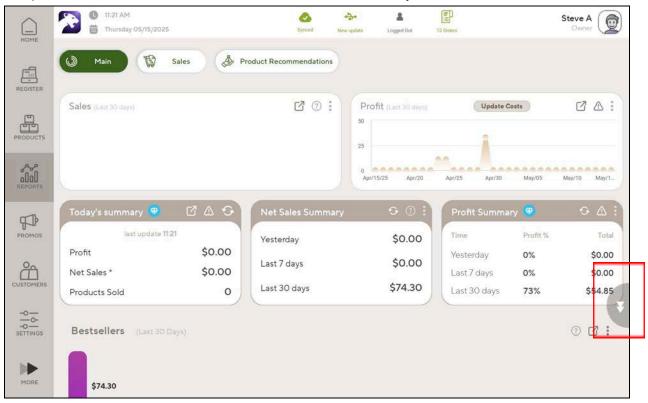
You can also print your end of day report by tapping on the purple Print Report button on the top right hand side of the page.

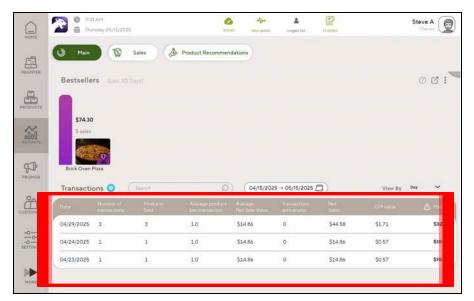


You can also see additional information by tapping on the **Reports** button from the home screen.

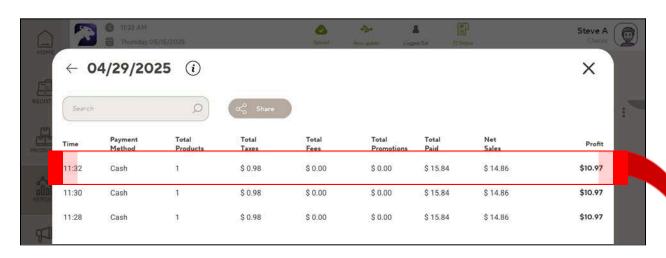


In reports, scroll down to the bottom for a breakdown of the days sales transactions.

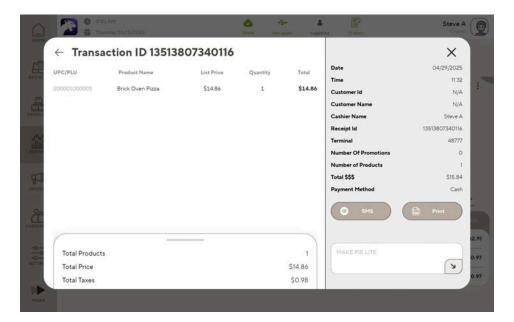




When you tap on one of the transaction lines it will bring up all the transactions within that line (in this case - day)



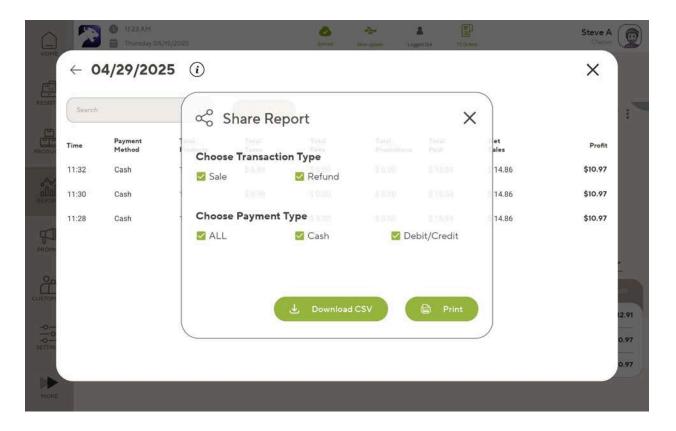
By tapping on an individual transaction, you will open up the receipt view. You can then reprint it or send it as an SMS.



You can also share the report by tapping the Share report button at the top of the transaction list



You will then be able to print to your local receipt printer or download the data as a CSV.



Improved Logout Experience

A log-out option is now available in the user-avatar dropdown-menu in the register and on the Home screen.

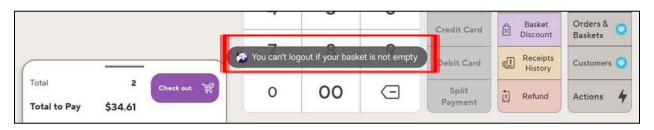
Home Screen Logout

NOTE: Logging out is disabled whenever a basket is open. This prevents accidental cashier sign-off when a sale is in progress.

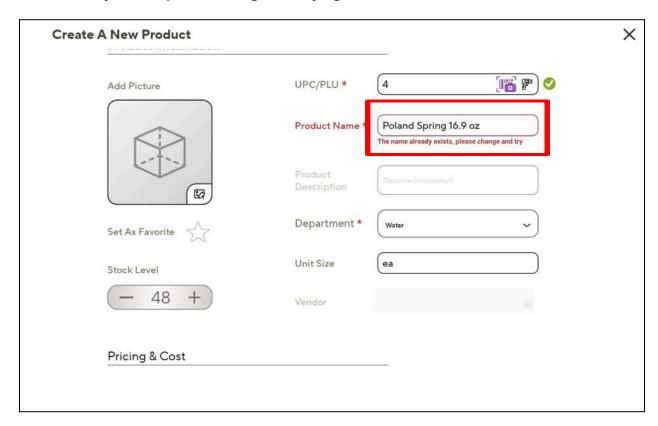


Not Allowing Duplicate Names of Entities

Panther now won't allow the creation of 2 items from the same family (taxes, products promotions etc.) with the same name. No more duplicate names for catalogue items

Panther will now **not allow** the creation of two items with the same name for any of the following: **Products, Modifiers, Modifier Groups, Promotions, Saved Baskets, Clubs, Rewards, and Pay-With-Points rules.**

If you try to save a duplicate, the field will be highlighted in red and display an error message Name already exists, please change and try again.



NOTE: Existing duplicates can still be used, but users can no longer add new ones.

The purpose of this update is to eliminate reporting confusion and sync errors between Panther, Classic POS, and the Merchant Portal.

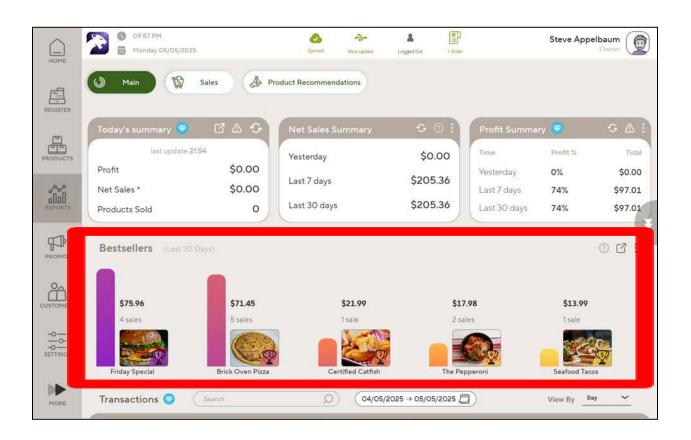
Product Sales Report - from Reports Bestsellers

Tapping any item in **Bestsellers** now opens the dedicated **Product Sales View**

From the **Home** screen select the **Reports** button



This will bring you to the **Reports Main** screen. In the middle of the screen are the **Bestsellers** using data from the last 30 days.



When you tap on each item in the Bestsellers window you will get an expanded view of that item
